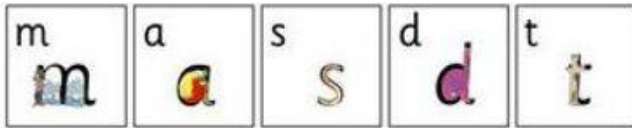


## Read, Write Inc – Home Learning A Set 1 - 1

### Writing



The sounds we are revising this week are:

**m, a, s, d, t**

Practise writing these letters as much as you can making sure that you form them correctly.

The handwriting rhymes we use to help us are:

<b>m</b>	Down Maisie then over the two mountains. Maisie, mountain, mountain.
<b>a</b>	Round the apple, down the leaf.
<b>s</b>	Slither down the snake.
<b>d</b>	Round his bottom, up his tall neck and down to his feet.
<b>t</b>	Down the tower, across the tower.

### Reading

Practise your blending using some Fred Games!

Fred is a frog that can only say sounds. We have to help him blend the sounds into words!

Play Fred says...



1. Say: Fred says put your hands on your h-ea-d. Ask children to repeat. Pause to allow children to jump in with the whole word and do the action.
2. Say: h-ea-d, head. Ask children to repeat.
3. Repeat with: b-a-ck, t-u-m, l-e-g, h-a-n-d, f-oo-t, kn-ee
