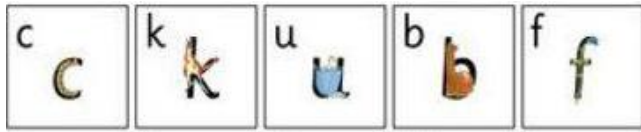


Read, Write Inc – Home Learning – Set 1 -3

Writing



The sounds we are revising this week are:

c, k, u, b, f

Practise writing these letters as much as you can making sure that you form them correctly.

The handwriting rhymes we use to help us are:

c	Curl around the caterpillar.
k	Down the kangaroo's body, tail and leg.
u	Down and under, up the top and draw the puddle.
b	Down the laces to the heel, round the toe.
f	Down the stem and draw the leaves.

Reading

Practise your blending using some Fred Games!

Fred is a frog that can only say sounds. We have to help him blend the sounds into words!

Play Fred I spy...



1. Say: Fred says 'I spy something r-e-d' Ask children to repeat. Pause to allow children to 'jump-in' with the whole word and point to something red.
2. Say: r-e-d, red. Ask children to repeat.
Repeat with: b-l-ue, g-r-ee-n, b-l-a-ck, b-r-ow-n

Challenge

Words to practise reading. Get a grown up to write the words down. Have a go at reading them, pointing at each sound and blending the sounds together (Fred talking)

Bed, met, get, bin, cat, cot, can, kit, mud, up, cup, bad
