Writing



The sounds we are revising this week are:

j, v, y, w,

Practise writing these letters as much as you can making sure that you form them correctly.

The handwriting rhymes we use to help us are:

j	Down his body, curl and dot.
v	Down a wing, up a wing.
y	Down a horn, up a horn and under his head.
w	Down up, down up

Reading

Practise your blending using some Fred Games!

Fred is a frog that can only say sounds. We have to help him blend the sounds into words!

Play Fred's wardrobe...



1. Fred went to his wardrobe and got a s-o-ck. Ask children to repeat. Pause to allow children to 'jump-in' with the whole word. Can they work it out?
2. Repeat with t-o-p, c-oa-t, h-a-t, d-r-e-ss (stick to items with no more than 4 sounds)

Challenge

Words to practise reading. Get a grown up to write the words down. Have a go at reading them, pointing at each sound and blending the sounds together (Fred talking)

Red, run, rat, jog, jet, jam, vet, yap, yes, yet, yum, web, win, wish, wet, sock

Spelling

Use you Fred fingers, count the sounds and have a go at spelling the words:

red

jog

vet

web

wish

sock

If you can manage these try spelling some other words from the reading list.
