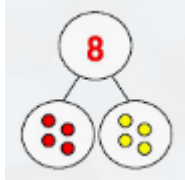

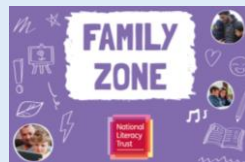
### Science – Habitats

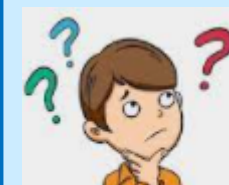
### Write a book review.

### Habitats and micro habitats

A habitat is a home environment for plants and animals or other organisms to grow. Examples of habitats include, a desert, meadow, woodland, grassland, forest, seashore or an ocean.

A micro habitat is a very small, specific Habitat for animals and plants, for example a rock pool or a rotting log.

### Human and physical features

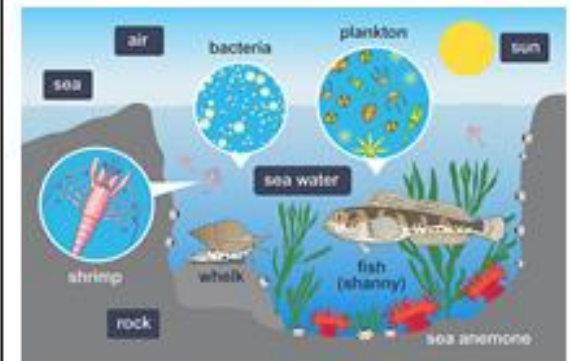
Physical features show natural objects such as mountains, beaches and rivers.
