

Mathematics.

In Year 1 we are beginning to look at subtraction.
Can you create a subtraction story?
How many eggs altogether? How many have been cracked open? Can you write a number sentence using the correct symbols



This week Year 2 children will be consolidating our work on addition including using the column method. Practise some simple addition problems like $9+7 =$ and move on to using 2-digit numbers e.g. $24+18 =$

Spelling


Practise spelling the green speedy words from your Read Write Inc book.


