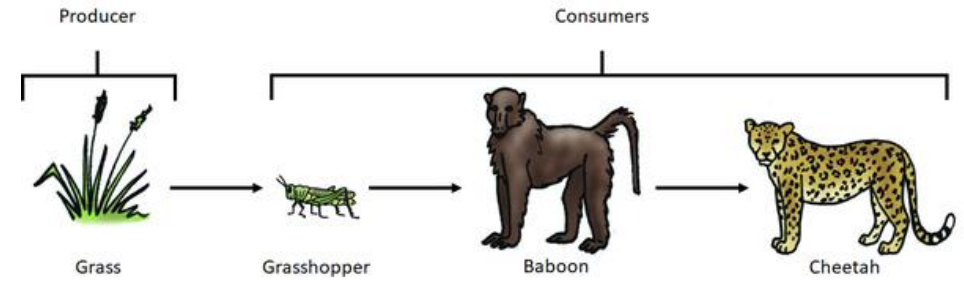


# KS1 Science Knowledge Organiser - Spring 1

## Living things and their habitats (Y2)



| Key Vocabulary        |  |
|-----------------------|--|
| Living things         | All living things can reproduce, grow, move, breathe, adapt or respond to their environment.                                     |
| Dead                  | No longer alive.   |
| Alive                 | Not dead.  |
| Have never been alive | Anything metal, plastic or stone has never been alive.   |
| Habitat               | Places where animals and plants live.  |
| Micro habitat         | A very small part of a habitat, such as a clump of grass or a space between rocks.   |
| Basic needs           | Living things need four things to survive: air so that they can breathe, water and food to survive, and shelter to protect them. |
| Food chain            | A diagram that shows us how animals are linked by what they eat.   |
| Producer              | The name given to a living thing that produces its own food.   |
| Consumer              | A living thing that consumes (eats) another living thing for food, in order to get energy.                                       |
| Predator              | An animal that hunts and eats another animal to eat them for food.   |
| Prey                  | An animal that is hunted by another for food.  |
