Human features	Things that are made or built by humans
Physical features	Anything that is on the Earth naturally
Urban	Town or city
Rural	Countryside
Population	All the inhabitants of a particular place
Climate graphs	Shows the yearly temperature and rainfall for a location
Regions	An area
Amazonia	Land around the Amazon River
Tropical	Belonging to, or typical of the Tropics
Poverty line	An estimated minimum of income to support the necessities of life
Favela	Brazilian slum
Rainfall	The fall of rain
Semi-arid forest	A forest with a dry, desert like climate
Coastal forest	Forests along the coast
Push factors	Something that makes someone want to leave a place
Pull factors	Something that attracts people to a place
Deforestation	Purposeful clearing of forested land
Indigenous peoples	Distant social and cultural groups that share collective ancestral ties to the lands and natural resources where they live, occupy or from which they have been displaced
